- The Brandt Family Scholarship is payable upon completion of the first semester of post-secondary education with proof (college or trade school transcript) of passing grades.

### **APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

The Brandts are a service driven family and as such are firm believers in the value and power of higher education. The opportunity to help a Lake City student each year with a scholarship underscores their desire to help Lake City grow as a community by helping students to strive for excellence and be able to exemplify a sense of community service as they grow in their respective careers.

The format for this application is an essay that will address areas such as growing up in a small town, your academic areas of interest, and personal experiences or situations that have most impacted you. Think about how you see your life up to this point in time, changing as a result of higher education.

Your application will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

#### Format:

- Typed, double spaced in a 12 point font.
- Margins should be 1"
- o Length of the essay should be a minimum of two pages, not to exceed four pages.
- Readability: Minimal (preferably none) spelling, grammatical or sentence structure errors. Please proof read and spell / grammar check your essay before submission.
- Content: Please address the following questions as they pertain to you.

### Personal Achievements

What achievements are your most proud of, such as academic, leadership, service, honors and awards or are there any other accomplishments you want to mention?

## Personal experiences & their impact

- What personal experience or situation has been a positive influence on you? Please explain how it impacted you in such a positive way.
- What personal experience or situation has been a challenging influence on you? Please explain how this challenge ultimately impacted the person you are today?

# Choosing an area of study and making a career plan

- o What course of study do you plan to follow to achieve your career choice?
- O What is your school of choice?
- Where do you see yourself in five years (please close your essay with this).

#### Financial Need

- Please explain if you have a financial need and if so, why this is important to support your educational goals.
- Explain why you need this scholarship money. How will it help you?
- Communication of ideas: It is important to convey your thoughts and ideas in a clear and articulate manner. For example it is easy to just list accomplishments, but try to expand your thoughts to reflect some level of analysis of the examples you provide. It is important to reflect about how you have grown as a person and where you see yourself in the future.
